Draws

Draws will be done “live” in the General Meeting. After the General Meeting, our staff will print the draws and hand them over to the countries officials, present at “After GM diner”. The draws will be put online, please download at your tablets.

Registration

Registration is at the Coque on FRIDAY from 2-6pm. The team chief is asked to pay the inscriptions and hand over the “athlete” cards to their competitors. Each competitor has to show up with his/her card at the weighting desk to get it stamped, kata competitors as well! In case of bad inscription (wrong age or weight) a penalty of 10€ will have to be paid, a new card will be printed.

Bus transfers

Bus from Airport Hotels, Ibis and Campanile, will leave at 7.45 am in front of the hotels.

Competition

We have some rules, which we kindly ask everybody to observe.

Competitors are asked to use warming up area for warming up. 15 minutes before the beginning of their category, they will be called up by our staff team and brought to the tatami area, together with the coach. **ONLY** competitors and coaches are allowed to enter tatami area and this only with a staff member!!! Competitors will wait in a special “tatami waiting area” and chairs for the “next fighter” (and coach) will be set next to the tatami. Competitors will be invited by the staff to use these chairs. Please do **not** leave the “tatami waiting area” until the end of your category (because of repêchage)!

We will award the medals IMMEDIATELY after each category. The winners of the 3rd places and the finalist are asked to stay close to the podium. After the “medal ceremony”, please leave the tatami area immediately.

Opening ceremony

ALL referees, competitors and coaches are asked to line up behind their flag in the “opening ceremony preparation room” at 12.45pm! We start the opening ceremony as soon as the special guests are seated. After the official speeches, competitors and referees will leave the tatami-area and can watch the demonstration from the stands and tribunes.

After the opening ceremony, we will immediately continue the competition. The categories that are concerned should be prepared in the warming up area.

Sayonara party
